

# Basic Disaster Life Support™ 3.0 Course



The Basic Disaster Life Support (BDLS®) course aims to improve the care and coordination of response for disasters and other public health emergencies by developing a common approach and language among multiple disciplines in the health care community. This course targets emergency medical service providers, nurses, physicians, hazardous materials personnel, public health personnel and other health care professionals simultaneously and offers a review of natural disasters, traumatic and explosive, nuclear and radiological, biological and chemical events. Information on the health care professional's role in public health and incident management systems, community mental health and special needs of vulnerable populations is also included in the BDLS course.
